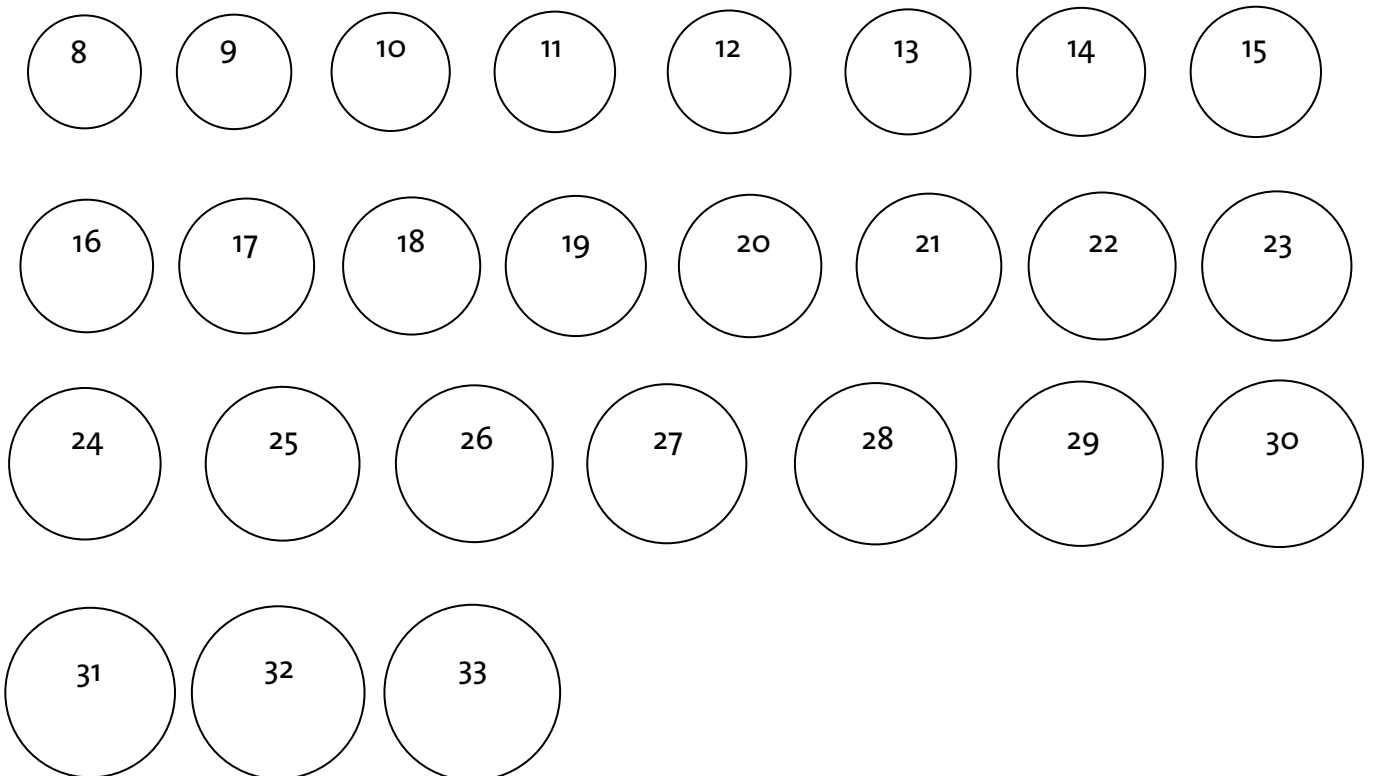
### MEASURE YOUR RING

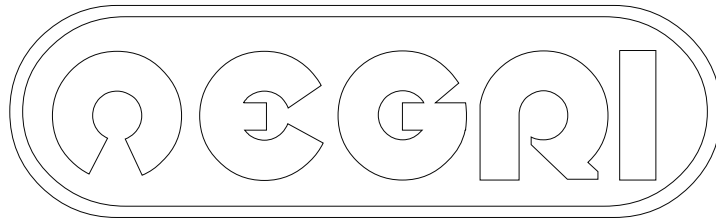
To understand which technical size you wear, please take one of your rings that fits perfectly, a simple ring will be ideal for this measurement.

Now, print this page and, with a ruler, check the reference of scale “3 cm” in the upper right of the page, make sure that the red line is actually 3 cm long (print on A4 paper without resizing the page).

If the scale is ok, choose the measurement by placing the ring on the paper: the inner diameter of the ring must match the diameter of one of the circles.

### **FIT OF THE RINGS**

The fit of the rings varies depending on the model. In principle, all the band rings such as the Dachshunds and Felix rings have poor wearability. The higher the band the less is the wearability. To fit means the adaptability and the adherence to the finger, and can be defined:

**STANDARD**, is a close fit to the actual size of the finger.

**TIGHT**, is a fit that tends to tighten, It may be the case to choose a bigger size (1 size more).

**ABUNDANT**, is a fit that leaves space between the finger and the ring.
